

S.S. "FALCON".

The General Steam Navigation Co. Ltd.

The Owners state that in the early part of 1937 they will insulate the after hold of this vessel, and they propose to fit a second hand refrigerating machine which they have purchased from Messrs. J. & E. Hall Ltd., two brine pumps and spares, similarly to their vessel "CORMORANT", which arrangement was approved in the Secretary's letter of the 26th November, 1935.

The vessel will be employed on the near continental trades with voyages of short duration, and the owners ask if the one refrigerating machine can be approved in these circumstances.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Owners be informed that in view of the short duration of the voyages, the proposed refrigerating machinery might be approved provided the working parts are opened up for examination, the hydraulic and air tests and other requirements of the Rules for Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances be complied with, and the installation be found satisfactory.

It should, however, be pointed out that in the event of the vessel being engaged on other trade routes entailing voyages of longer duration, the case will require to be reconsidered.

A list of the proposed spare gear should be submitted for consideration.
