

Motorship "BRUNA"

Date of Build - 1947
Owned by - Messrs. Societe Liberienne de
Transports Maritimes, S.A.
Registered in Liberia.

This ship was built in 1947 and classed with the Registro Italiano.

Subsequently the class 100A- "West African and Spanish Coasting Service" was assigned by the Society.

The class was expunged from the Register Book in February, 1954, on account of non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

A Reclassification Survey was carried out at Las Palmas in September/November, 1956, and the class was reinstated in December, 1956, 100A1 "West African and Spanish Coasting Service".

At the time of the Reclassification Survey, the weights of the anchors were not reported, and the class was made subject to the weights of the anchors being supplied and found in accordance with the Rules by the next drydocking.

The ship has not been inspected by the Society's Surveyors since the Reclassification Survey, and a drydocking survey is now considerably overdue.

A number of letters have been written to the Owners at various addresses, the last of which was supplied by The Liberian Authorities in New York, and the Society's Surveyor at Las Palmas has also attempted to contact the Owners through their Agents there. All of these attempts have been unsuccessful, and we have been unable to obtain any proposal as to when the ship will be submitted for survey in drydock.
