It is with very considerable regret that I find that to date the above matters have not been satisfactorily dealt with and I regret this more as the reclassing certificates were issued by the Register in the belief, because of my statement, that the matters would have been attended to before your vessel sailed from Monrovia.

You have since had several letters addressed to you on the matter, including one from Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, dated 11th. November 1957, and yet the matter has not been attended to.

I have, therefore, of necessity had to write on the matter to the Register and I have also had to point out that you are now overdue for your annual docking survey. Failing the very early arranging of these different matters I feel sure that the Committee will immediately reconsider the question of your being retained in class. If you should again be expunged for non-compliance with the Regulations I am certain that it will be a matter of great regret to all concerned.

Please be good enough to give this matter your very urgent and very earnest attention.
