I have received a letter written in Spanish from the Agents of the above vessel in Tenerife, and enclose herewith a translation in English, also enclosed herewith is my reply to them. In going through my files I find that I carried out and charged for Hull, Machinery and Load Line surveys, and, on 6th December 1956, I wrote you enclosing my reports and asking at the same time that you issue a new Free board Certificate and a new Measurement Certificate. In due course I received from you the Machinery Reclassification Certificate No. 30238 and I sent this, on to the Owners in Tenerife, on 11th February. I have no record of either the Owners or myself having received a new Load line Certificate or a new Measurement Certificate, nor have I any advice of them having been refused for any reason whatsoever.

My understanding therefore of the position of the vessel at today's date is thus:

1.- Machinery Reclassification Certificate No. 30238 issued from London to me and sent by me to Owners.

2.- Hull Reclassification Certificate not issued pending satisfactory equipment survey.

3.- Load line survey carried out by me; certified copy of certificate on board endorsed by me, and letter written to you, asking that a new Load line Certificate be issued, as the original had been lost.

4.- Letter written by me asking that a new Measurement Certificate be issued, as the certificate had been lost.

Please be good enough to give me the latest position regarding this vessel in view of the enclosures and my letter.
