Reclassification etc.

Herewith the reports of the above vessel for Reclassing and Special Survey of vessel and Machinery, also the Annual Load Line Survey report, all of which I trust you will find in good order.

The vessel is intended to arrive here to take stores and ice next week, and I shall take the opportunity to check the weight of the anchors. I have not been able to do so up to now, and there are no distinguishable marks on the shank. I am also not sure of the letter for the equipment but assume it to be 'a' and the length and size of chain cable conform to this letter. The Owners assure me that the cable and anchors are the original and there have been no cable or anchor changes since vessel arrived Tenerife 4 years ago. The authorities confirm this.

FREEBOARD CERT.- It will be appreciated by the Owners if a new certificate is granted.

MEASUREMENT CERT.- It will also be appreciated by the Owners if a new certificate of measurement is granted. No alterations to the vessel have taken place.

In a letter, written in Spanish (copy herewith) the Owners Agent, thanks me for concluding the surveys, acknowledges receipt of the Interim Certs., copies herewith, and asks if all the original certs., could be sent by the Society to,
