I would confirm my cablegram to you in the case of the "BRUNA" as per enclosed copy. In amplification I can only say that while we should be prepared to authorise you to carry out a Special Survey Type C for reclassification, it is considered necessary that, in the first instance, we should have plans of proposed structural alterations for approval in this Office.

It occurs to me, however, that the Owners may be confusing the Corporation of Lloyd's and Lloyd's Register in that they have apparently asked Lloyd's Agents for the ship to be classed and insured. I understand that Lloyd's Agents are authorised by the Corporation of Lloyd's to appoint Surveyors for insurance purposes at the request of Owners, and it is thought possible that the survey now required by the Owners may merely be one for the information of underwriters.
