MOTORSHIP "BRUNA"

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 24th ult., under the above heading, contents of which have been duly noted.

We regret that we did not request the Society's Surveyor either at Gibraltar or at Ceuta to make the examination of the screwshaft, as we were not aware that same was required.

For your guidance and information, we have pleasure in sending you enclosed, herewith, report dated Ceuta, 17th February last, issued by the Comisariado Español Marítimo at that port, after examination of the damage and of the repairs carried out, which we trust will be of use to your goodselves.

However, in the event of this document not meeting your requirements, we shall be pleased to indicate, in due course, the date on which the "BRUNA" will call at a port, so that you may advise the Society's Surveyor and instruct him to make the examination of the screwshaft.
