to an additional bilge pump (now on board) being fitted at
the first available opportunity, also to the screw shaft
being re-examined before the end of April, 1953.

The Notation NE made & fitted '51 has
also been made in the Register Book.

The torsional characteristics of the main
engines have not been investigated.
