Tug "TEMPLE CROSS"

The case of the above named ship has received the consideration of the Committee today in connection with your letter of the 14th instant.

The Committee desire the Owners should be informed that, while the Committee are anxious to help them in every way practicable, it would be contrary to their procedure to agree to a postponement of six months beyond a year of grace for a Special Survey in a case of this nature.

They suggest, however, that the Owners offer the tug for a Modified Special Survey with a validity of twelve months, which means that she should be completely examined as for a full Special Survey, but that any recommendations for repairs can be limited to those which are considered essential for the twelve months contemplated.
