Marine Engineers (Fleetwood) Ltd., on the 12th December, 1957, and subsequently for the purpose of examining and testing the undermentioned boiler mountings, which have been removed from the boiler of the S.T. " MARGARET WICKS ", 366 Tons gross of Fleetwood, - this boiler now being cut up for scrap.

- 1 - 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " C.I. Winch shut off Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " G.M. Auxiliary Check Valve, and stub spigoted connection.
- 1 - 2" G.M. Main Check Valve and stub spigoted connection.
- 1 - 3" C.I. Auxiliary Stop Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Bottom Shut off Cock (to boiler shell).
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Top Boiler Shut off Cook.
- 1 - 1" G.M. Stop Valve to Circulating Pump.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Blow Down Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " G.M. Steering Engine Stop Valve.
- 1 - 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " C.I. Main Stop Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Dynamo Stop Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Windlass Stop Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Whistle Stop Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Oil Fuel System Stop Valve.
- 1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " G.M. Accomodation Heating Stop Valve.
- 1 - C.I. Cockburn (No.58) Safety valve Chest (2 valves each 3" diameter)
Casting Inlet 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
Waste Steam 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

All the above mountings have been opened up, overhauled as necessary, examined, and subsequently submitted to hydraulic tests of 550 lbs/sq.in., and found satisfactory.
