Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines  
in South Shields

The following alterations were found to have been made :-

- Dispensed with:
- 1) Scupper discharging below freeboard deck in way of the Forecastle
  - 2) Sanitary discharge from Bridge amid through No. 3 Hold.
  - 3) Poop Bulkhead - Steel plates bolted with fixed bolts.

- Now fitted:
- 1) Sanitary discharge from W.C. under the overhang of Fore Deck (P) discharging above freeboard ~~through~~ *stow valve*
  - 2) Sanitary discharge from Bridge amid through Deep Tank. *fitted with stow valve.*
  - 3) Seamen's & Fireman's washpans (P.S.) in the Poop (after end) :-
    - a) Soil water drain from washbasins P.S. (1 1/2" dia) fitted with ordinary screw down valve, operated from within the space ✓
    - b) Drain from the deck P.S. (1 1/2" dia) ~~fitted with screw plug on keel drain~~ *fitted with S.D.N.R. valves See Col. C11/cont*
 These discharges are above freeboard deck
  - 4) Poop Bulkhead - No openings. *Noted*
