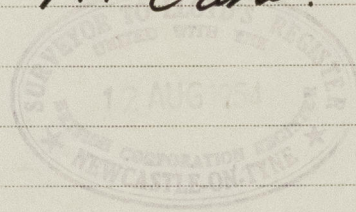

The discharges from the deck scuppers (P.S.) in the Seamen's and Firemen's washplaces within the poop have now been fitted with two inch screw down automatic non-return valves. These valves have extended spindles and may be operated by handwheels fitted below the wash basins in the respective washplaces.

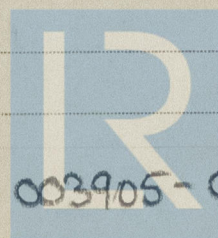
