
We acknowledge with thanks your letter dated 3rd March, and in reply we have to inform you as follows:

2146 T/S/S "MEXOIL" - This vessel is in winter quarters at Toronto, and in a recent discussion with Captain Furlong, Vice-President of Gayport Shipping Limited, we were informed that it is most unlikely this vessel will be in service this year.

2112 S/S "ASHCROFT" - This vessel is in Winter quarters at Walkerville, Ontario, and the Machinery and Boilers are now under survey, and the shortage of Chain Cable has been brought to the attention of the Marine Superintendent.


