When this ship was at Singapore last month she was examined in drydock and the Main Boiler Survey held. Fresh records of DS 4.64 and MBS 4.64 have been assigned.


The Surveyor reported that the port and starboard L.P. cylinders were specially examined and found to continue efficient. Class has been continued however subject to these items being again examined by the end of April 1965.

The port and starboard sterntube nuts were also specially examined and found to remain efficient but it has been recommended that these items be again examined next drydocking, class being continued meanwhile, subject to this matter receiving attention by that time.
