Motorship "KOBI MARU"

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th April and am much obliged to you for the information furnished therein.

The circumstances have been reviewed by the Committee here and they have little doubt that the class should be withdrawn.

They note, however, that the vessel is laid up pending final instructions for scrapping; they have therefore deferred consideration of the case until the end of next week in the hope that a definite decision will then have been reached by the Managers, in which event the case will merely be marked "to be broken up".

I shall therefore be grateful if you will cable here in time for the Committee Meeting on Friday, 18th instant, as to whether any further information has been received from the Managers.
