This is to Certify that the Engines and Boilers of the
Steel Screw Steamer "Point Pelee Park"
7199 Tons, of *Montreal*
Built at *Montreal, Que.* in *1942*
have been surveyed at *Montreal, Que.*
in *August 1942*
by the Surveyors to this Society, and reported to be in good,
efficient, and safe working condition, at a pressure of *220* lb.
per square inch on the main boilers. The approved working pressure
of the donkey boiler is *8* lb. per square inch.

The survey having been completed, the Record *LMC 8,42*
(Lloyd's Machinery Certificate) has been made in the Register
Book, subject to Periodical Surveys as required by the Rules.

The class is assigned and maintained upon the understanding that the ^{electrical installation} equipment will be made
to accord with the requirements of the Rules when the present state of emergency has passed.
