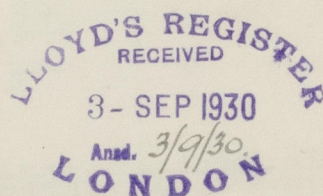

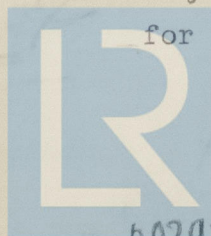
We are desirous of regaining Class 100 A.1 in
