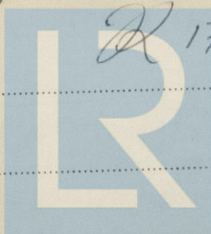
On 2.2.60, the ship remaining laid up, the Committee agreed to the class remaining undisturbed, provided the outstanding surveys were carried out before the ship again proceeded to sea.

The Secretary, New York states that the Owners are now considering re-activating the ship and are prepared to carry out a General Examination in view of the fact that the Special Survey is now overdue, but as the Owners plan to submit the ship to all Classification Surveys at a Mediterranean port, they wish to hold the General Examination afloat. On completion of the General Examination the ship will sail in ballast direct to Palermo or a Greek port.
