

EXTRACT FROM LETTER RECEIVED FROM

TRADING WITH THE ENEMY DEPARTMENT  
(Treasury and Board of Trade)

24, Kingsway,

London, W.C.2.

6th May, 1944.

"As regards the particular case of the "SKANSEN", the Board hereby grant to your Society such authority as may be necessary under the said Act to permit its Surveyor at Gothenburg to hand over to the builders the usual classification certificate provided :-

- (1) that the actual particulars shall not be inserted in the Society's Register Book, and
- (2) that the Surveyor shall previously communicate with H.M. Minister at Stockholm and obtain his permission to do so.

You will therefore no doubt wish to instruct your Society's Surveyor at Gothenburg that in respect of both the above-mentioned matters he should communicate forthwith with H.M. Minister and act as permitted by him. Will you be good enough to let the Board have a copy of the telegram which is despatched in due course. "
