
Gentlemen:

With reference to your letter of August 24, 1964 and our telephone conversation of August 26, 1964, I wish to request at this time that any dry docking concerning the M/T "JOAN" be postponed until the last week in January or the first week in February, 1965. The reason for this is that at the present time we are on a long term contract with the Hercules Powder Company of Wilmington, Delaware and we have to stay at the Brunswick Port Authority Dock for 20 days at one time and then, we are under way 20 days at a time.
