and have read your remarks to the Committee today.

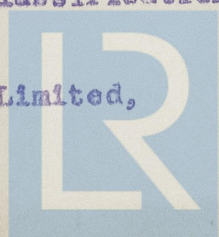
In reply I am pleased to inform you that with a view to assisting you as far as practicable in the present difficult circumstances, the Committee are agreeable to a Modified Survey for a contemplated period of two years being held in each instance, and the Society's Surveyor at Curacao is being instructed to hold such an inspection on application from your local Office. It is noted that you will arrange for Boiler and other surveys to be held in the normal way, and it is thought well to draw your attention to the fact that Screwshaft Surveys are already considerably overdue in some of the cases mentioned by you.

You will doubtless arrange for a Loadline Renewal Survey to be held at the same time, so that a Load Line Certificate with a similar period of validity may be issued.
