The Owners now state that owing to the Suez Canal affair this ship will be required for some 18/24 months after present expiry of the class and they therefore propose to submit the ship to Modified Special Survey at Curacao as opportunity offers with a view to further extension of class for 1 1/2 years. The Owners further add that Boiler and other due surveys will be carried out as vessel comes in for annual drydocking and repairs.

* Overdue Screwshaft Survey need only be insisted upon in the case of single screw ships unless the wear down of the stern bush is found excessive.
