An Owners' request for extension of ship's class for six months has been approved provided the ship is opened up and examined as for a Special Survey in dry dock. See correspondence.

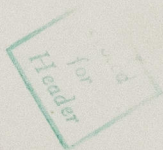
The CURACAO Surveyors report (11,56), this tanker examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the requirements of a Modified Special Survey for a period of six months complied with.
