Dear Sir,

We acknowledge with thanks your "Air Mail" letter dated 29th November, and in reply, we confirm that the above mentioned ship was deepened from 20' to 24' by raising the freeboard deck and forecastle complete. The length of the ship is 253' and the raised quarter deck is 100' in length, therefore the length of the portion raised is 153'.

Addition to equipment tonnage is -

153' x 43.166 x 4 ft. .75 :	100 - 198
cubic tonnage from Register	1851
corrected cubic tons	<u>2049</u>

It should, however, be pointed out that no change has been made in the equipment of this ship nor of her sister ships previously deepened. The equipment numeral remains unchanged as in the case of the S.S. "TROISDOC" and "PRESCODOC".

We confirm that there is now no Raised Quarter Deck.
