The Credley Boiler Co. Ltd., attend their works at Credley Heath on the 24th May, 1933 and subsequently for the purpose of inspecting and witnessing the hydraulic test on three mild steel riveted air receivers, Nos. 19863, 19866/7, made to the orders of The Newbury Diesel Co. Ltd., Nos. 6272/2100, 7060/2020, 7061/2100.

The plates from which the receivers were made were identified from the signed mill sheets, the receivers were examined during construction, the workmanship throughout being satisfactory. When completed, they were tested by hydraulic pressure to 600 lb. per square inch, examined under this pressure and were, as far as could be seen, satisfactory, showing no signs of leakage.

For the purpose of identification the receivers were marked -

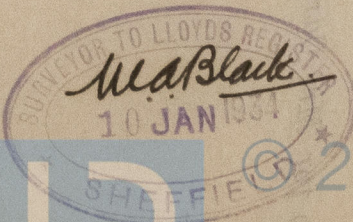
