Dear Sirs,

World Tankers Corporation.

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo, and note that you wish your steam ships to be placed on an Engine Survey basis, for machinery surveys.

I would explain that reversion from the Continuous Survey system to the Engine Survey basis can only be done if a full Engine Survey is held. As, however, an Engine Survey can be held over a period of one year, any parts examined for Continuous Survey within and during the year in which it is intended to hold the Engine Survey will be credited towards the Engine Survey.

A list of ships and the requirements necessary for each vessel is appended. The requirements are based on the assumption that the Surveys will be done at the due date, and on the understanding that delay in holding the Engine Survey may involve the examination of more items.
