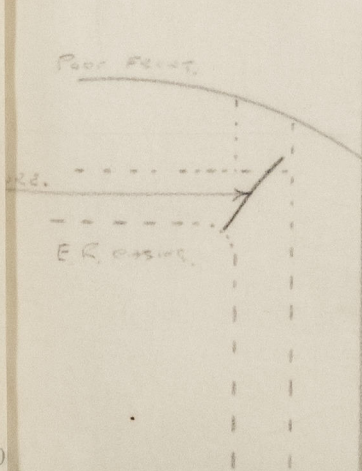

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners' Agents Messrs, Kanakaris ve Mahdumi, attend aboard the hulk World Harmony, on receipt of information that a fracture had occurred in upper deck plating starboard side of poop passage way as she lay afloat in Beykoz Bay 25th March 1961.

A crack approx. 4 ft long was found at the forward corner of the Engine Room casing in upper deck in poop, running at approx 45° to centre line forward and outboard.

The Owners' agents have been again advised that the recommendations made for a ballast condition, giving reduced Bending Moments, was detailed in the Secretary letter of 6th January 1961. should be carried out. i.e. No.1 Std. tank emptied, No.10 C and 10 S tanks filled and approx 1500 tons of water put in No.8 C tank.
