Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines  
in S AN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA.

ALTERATIONS COMPLETED AT SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA, JANUARY 18th, 1944.

ADDITIONAL SCUPPER DISCHARGE (1) FITTED FROM:

FORWARD STARBOARD UPPER NO. 2 TWEEN DECK

The soil pipe discharges overboard at the forward starboard side of the No. 2  
Lower Tween Deck.

A cast steel non-return clapper valve is fitted to the ship's side. An approved  
cast steel positive action gate valve is bolted to the clapper valve, and an  
extension rod with indicating hand wheel and operated from the Upper Tween Deck  
is connected to the gate valve.

Rods are made flexible by use of universal joints.
