



The Safety Valves of both boilers have been adjusted to 150 lbs per square inch, and the following adjusting washers have been fitted:-

Port boiler:-	port	6.4 mm
	starboard	7.2 mm
Starboard boiler:-	port	7.5 mm
	starboard	5.9 mm
