With reference to the case of the transversely framed tanker "SKOTAAS", in which the Committee gave instructions on the 31st ultimo for the notation "Class suspended as vessel reported outside approved trading limits" to be recorded in the Register Book, I have to inform you that as a result of further representations on the part of the Owner they have now cancelled the previous suspension of class on the understanding that the vessel will proceed from Melbourne to the Persian Gulf in the ballast condition, and thence to United Kingdom/Continent with a cargo of crude oil, for the requisite stiffening.
