Transversely Framed Tanker "SKOTAA S"

Your cablegram of the 7th instant duly reached this Office and the case has been submitted to the Committee today, together with your confirmatory letter of the same date.

The Committee do not see any reason as to why they should reverse their previous decision, and have accordingly continued the suspension of class until the ship returns to her approved trading limits. When that is so they will be prepared to consider the deletion of the notation "Class suspended as vessel reported outside approved trading limits" but in any event they will still require the necessary stiffening to be fitted before the end of September next if the ship is to retain her class after that date.
