Transversely Framed Tanker "SKOTAAS"

Referring to your cable and letter of the 1st instant regarding the above ship we beg to acquaint you that we immediately informed the owner of the facts.

We have had a long telephonic conversation with the owner to-day, and have subsequently cabled you as follows:

"Skotaas your letter 1st instant owner strongly objects to suspension class 10th instant placing him in awkward position re. insurance stop. Vessel returning from Melbourne to Singapore area and owner endeavouring prevail charterers divert vessel to Europe stop. Owner again refers to previous surveys our letter 11th February last."

We may add that the owner was very anxious in the matter and sincerely hoped that some further arrangement might be possible. He stated that it would be hopeless for him to have any stiffening fitted in Australia or Singapore.
