Transversely Framed Tanker "SKOTAAS"

Reverting to my letter of the 20th February informing you that, with a view to meeting the Owner as far as possible, the Committee would be prepared to postpone the necessary deck stiffening until the end of September next, provided that in the meantime the vessel's service was limited to Singapore - Sumatra - Borneo, I have to inform you that your letter of the 23rd instant intimating that the ship is proceeding to Melbourne has been placed before the Committee for consideration.

In view of the fact that the vessel is proceeding outside the above-mentioned limits, the Committee have given instructions for the following notation to be recorded in the Register Book:-

"Class suspended as vessel reported outside approved trading limits"

and I shall be glad if you will convey this decision to the Owner.

The above decision will be put forward for confirmation on Friday, 10th instant, and should the Owner have any objections to raise, I shall be glad if you will transmit these to this Office in good time before that date, so that they may be considered by the Committee. I hereby confirm my cabled message to-day as per copy enclosed.
