Transversely Framed Tanker "SKOTAAS".

We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your cable of the instant regarding the above vessel, as follows viz.:-

"SKOTAAS REURCAB TODAY'S DATE FURNISH INFORMATION REGARDING SUBSEQUENT VOYAGES DURING PERIOD OF POSTPONEMENT DESIRED."

We immediately contacted the owner, and beg to quote his reply, as follows, viz.:-

"Thank you for your letter of the 22nd instant. As you will observe from my letters of the 12th and 15th instant, it is difficult to state anything definite about the future voyages, as the time charterers, The Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd, London arrange these.

Previous experience would, however, indicate that the vessel will be running in Eastern Waters for some time on. After discharge in Japan towards the end of February, I may presume that the M/S "SKOTAAS" will be diverted to the Singapore-Sumatra-Borneo run.

In accordance with a clause in the charter party, the "SKOTAAS" will towards autumn this year again be diverted to a North European port for drydocking and repairs, and I assume that Lloyd's will agree to the stiffening being postponed accordingly."
