I have to acquaint you that the Steel Twin Screw Motor Vessel "SKOTAAS", Messrs. The Caledon Shipbuilding and Engineering Co's Yard No. 335, has proceeded to your port with a view to the installation of the machinery.

To complete the Survey on the hull the following remains to be done:- Casings over machinery space to be closed, ceiling and sparring in forward hold to fit, vessel to dock for cleaning and painting &c., bilge suction, steering gears, anchors and windlass to be tested under working conditions.
