Dear Sirs,

E. With reference to the Motor Vessel "SKOTAAS" (The Caledon S.B.Co's Yard No.335) which is being towed to your port for installation of the machinery I think it well to quote for your information the following extract from the Sundee Surveyors' report, viz:-

"The Donkey Boilers have been satisfactorily fitted on board the vessel, the safety valves adjusted under steam and tried for accumulation; the boilers examined under working conditions and found satisfactory. The cargo heating pipes in all cargo tanks, frd.deep tank, side bunker tanks and aft peak, tested by hydraulic pressure. The bunker oil transfer pipes on deck, and pump room tested by hydraulic pressure. The sea connections exd. and found satisfactory."
