me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am
recommending that she be continued as now classed in the Register
book without fresh record of survey, subject to indented &
fractured s.s. sheer, 1st, 2nd & 3rd below bulwark, deck plating
internals in way being dealt with before the vessel is
recommissioned.
