I have to acquaint you that the new steamer "SEAFON",  
Messrs. Craig, Taylor & Co's S.S. No. 215, has left here for  
your port for finishing.

To complete the machinery survey the suction require  
to be fitted in the tunnel and afterhold wells.

The spare gear was examined here on the day that the  
vessel left and all was found in order except the assorted bolts,  
only twenty of which were supplied. It was arranged that the  
number should be increased and I shall be glad if you will kindly  
ascertain if a reasonable number has now been put on board.
