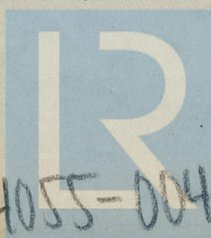

The castings consisting of 27 top half, 27 bottom half bearings and 9 nuts, after being hammered were examined and found so far as could be seen sound and free from blow holes.
