Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in —

The following alterations now carried out:—

New house made at aft end of shelter deck 24'0" long x 8'0" wide - plating .26", stiffeners 3 x 3½ x .30 OA. brackled top and bottom. Door openings (Pos) 4'6" x 2'3" x 18" coaming, hardwood doors fitted.

1 New 11" dia x .34" ventilator 30" high fitted at aft end of new house to accommodation below, ventilator fitted with wood plug and canvas cover.

1 - 3" dia, and 1 - 2" dia. additional air pipes fitted to no 6 double bottom tank - openings fitted with gauge and canvas covers.
