I have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules for loss of equipment alleged sustained on 28th August, 1965 and damage alleged sustained by heavy weather on 25th August, 1965 while on passage from Archangel to Cardiff.

Special Reasons List No. 241.

- (1) Dry Dock grounding. Nothing done at this time.
- (2) 15 fathoms of chain cable to be supplied. See under equipment.
- (3) Midship deckhouse forward plating starboard side, stiffening and coaming bar. Nothing done at this time.
- (4) Boat deck beams forward and shell plating in 2nd and 3rd below sheer abreast fore end of No.2 hatch starboard side and framing in way. Nothing done at this time.

Special Reasons List Appendix No.16. Nil.

Damage. Alleged sustained by heavy weather on 25th August, 1965, while on passage from Archangel to Cardiff. The cargo of pit props shifted and the deck cargo in way of Nos. 3 and 4 holds port side was lost overboard.

Approximately 100 feet of guard rails have now been renewed and two air pipe heads renewed. Repairs examined on completion and found satisfactory.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated. I recommend, therefore, that this ship remain as classed ~~without~~ without fresh record of dry docking subject

to all outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended but without condition regarding 15 fathoms of chain cable being supplied.

It was stated that the starboard anchor and eight fifteen fathom lengths of anchor cable had been lost on 28th August, 1965. The vessel, with a reported 14° port list, dropped the starboard anchor at Barry Roads while awaiting the pilot.

Attempts to lift the anchor proved unsuccessful and it was stated that this was due to a combination of the anchor having fouled an obstruction and to the excessive list of the ship. It was subsequently decided to cut the anchor and cable free. See Report 9A.

An Anchor and nine lengths of chain cable have been supplied, verified with certificates and fitted to the starboard side. See Report 8 (Eq) attached.

It is recommended that the condition of class regarding 15 fathoms of chain cable being supplied be now deleted.
