I am in receipt of your letter of Sept. 6th in connection with the completion of the special survey of the above vessel.

The items mentioned in your letter have now been dealt with in Penang on 15th September as follows:-

1. The Starboard Auxiliary Air Compressor was opened up for survey and on examination, the Pistons, Cylinders, Valves, Connecting Rod, Crankshaft and Bearings, and Intercooler were all found in good order.
2. The Starboard Auxiliary Engine was opened up for inspection and the Piston, Liner, Valves, Connecting Rod, Crankshaft, Bearings and Bolts, Cylinder and Cylinder Head were all found in good order.
New Piston, Liner and Rings, had been fitted on 5th September, 1949.
The Dynamo was examined and found in good condition.
3. The covers were removed from the two starting Air Receivers and the Receivers internally appeared to be in good condition. Mountings were opened up and placed in order.
4. The two general service pumps (driven by Auxiliary Engines) were opened up, examined and found in good order.

Regarding the Annual Load Line Survey Report for this vessel, I would advise you that this was mailed on 7th July 1949, and I trust it has now been safely received.
