The particulars and reports on the hull and equipment of this ship have been examined and found acceptable for class.

Your attention is drawn to the aft cargo tank which is separated from the machinery space by bunker tanks at wings and pump room at centre, which arrangement is not in strict accordance with British Corporation Rules but has been accepted previously in cases where tankers classed with the American Bureau have been transferred to B.C. class.

It is submitted that the hull and equipment of this ship is eligible for British Corporation class with the notation B.S. (Tanker) Oils - F.P. below 150 F.
