A special survey type 1 on the hull and machinery together with drydocking, tailshaft and annual loadline surveys have been carried out by the exclusive surveyors to the Society at San Francisco, San Diego, Cal. and Liverpool N.S. from December 13th 1948 until May 12th 1949.

On completion of the surveys, the surveyors report that the donkey boiler, evaporator and boiler feed pump are out of use due to damage. The surveyors consider the ship in an efficient and seaworthy condition and recommend classification with the Society.
