
## PROVISIONAL CLASSIFICATION REPORT

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners, Messrs. Newfoundland Tankers, Ltd., visit the steel screw Motor Tanker "SEKONK" of St. John's, Newfoundland, Official No. 191213, as she lay afloat at Liverpool, N. S. on various dates up to and including the 8th day of May, 1949, for the purpose of completing the Special Survey, which was commenced at San Francisco (See their Report No. 8800 dated 31st January, 1949).
