Steamer "WINWAR".

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 28th May, and have since submitted to the Committee here the report that has been received from Hong Kong.

The position is that this ship is not eligible under the Society's Rules to carry petroleum products as well as dry cargo at one and the same time.

From our point of view the ship is considered fit to carry petroleum products when no dry cargo is carried, or alternatively to load dry cargo when no petroleum is carried in her mid-ship tanks.

The class has, therefore, been amended to read "100A1 Oil Tanker - when no dry cargo is carried".
