I duly received your letter of the 21st instant respecting the motorship "ASHMORE", which vessel you are informed has been offered to Messrs. Vestlandske Petroleum-Compagni, of your port, for purchase.

I have been in communication with the Society's Newcastle Surveyors regarding the case, and they now confirm that the vessel has been laid up in the Tyne since the date of her Trial Trip.
