With reference to your First Entry Report No.88385 on the motor oil tanker "ASHMORE", I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyor at Bergen stating that he has been informed by the Vestlandske Petroleum Kompagni of that port that the vessel has been offered to them for purchase.

They state that she has run her trial trip, but has been laid up since that time, and they now ask whether the date of build could be altered to the date of the vessel being eventually taken over by them should the sale be effected.

It is not known here whether the vessel has actually been laid up since she was built, and I shall be glad if you can state if this is so.

I may perhaps add that should this information be confirmed it would be possible to inform the prospective purchasers that no alteration could be made in the date of build, but the dates of the Periodical Special Surveys Nos. 1, 2 & 3 could be dated from the time of the general examination of the vessel in dry dock in accordance with Paragraph 1, Page 13 of the Rules.


