Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant regarding the motor vessels "ADAPTITY", "ACTUALITY" and "PRIARGATE" and note your remarks.

In connection with the two first named cases, I enclose herewith a plan of replace shaft which was approved in January last for these vessels, and have today ascertained that these replace shafts are being made by Newbury Diesel Company at Newbury and will, it is hoped, be ready for delivery and fitting on board shortly.

As regards the "PRIARGATE", it will be necessary for the existing 6" diameter screwshaft to be replaced by one of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter before classification can be assigned, and I shall be glad if you will confer with the Goole Shipbuilding Co. Ltd. and the Owners and let me know what arrangements they are making or have made for this to be done.

Please let me know the name of the Makers of the replace shaft in order that the necessary instructions may be sent to the local Surveyors.
