Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 26th instant from which it is noted that the Builders are asking for the Classification Certificates for the motor vessels "ADAPTITY" and "ACTUALITY".

In connection therewith, I would refer you to my letter of the 18th in which it has been made clear that the Committee are not assigning classes to these vessels until the Society's requirements regarding the torsional vibration characteristics of the engines are complied with.

In these cases this involves the fitting of larger diameter screwshafts, and until a report is received of their fitment, no certificates can be issued.

The matter should be explained to the Builders in this light.
